- 3. Click "Cookies"

- 1. Choose Preferences > Privacy
- 2. Click on "Remove all Website Data"

9.12 For Mozilla Firefox

- 1. Choose the menu "tools" then "Options"
- 2. Click on the icon "privacy"
- 3. Find the menu "cookie" and select the relevant options

9.13 For Opera 6.0 and further

- 1. Choose the menu Files" > "Preferences"
- 2. Privacy
